Thanks to many of you for your response. As you know, Thursday's are always at best "organized confusion." Now, after speaking with our VC earlier today, we are asking for teams to have several of their student team members sign up for 2 to 3 hour volunteer sessions in helping at our Safety Glasses stations. Having to operate 2 stations for three days places a lot of stress on our volunteer base. So, discuss this with your team and have those students sign-up at Pit Administration on Thursday, February 27th. Thanks in advance for helping.

4. SAFETY, as always is our top priority. So, **just couple of reminders.....Do not forget your safety glasses.** Teams are required to provide all team members that will enter the Pits and/or playing field area approved safety glasses. This includes your load-in of your Robot and Pit materials on Wednesday and/or Thursday. **You must bring your own. We will not be issuing Safety Glasses for team members. Gloves...**make sure that those handling robots are wearing gloves to prevent "pinch point" and cut related injuries. And...as always...**closed toed shoes.** This year we will be

utilizing **one additional safety advisor** that will be on the floor. Thank you for your cooperation.
